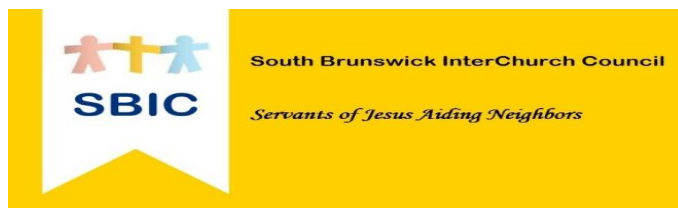

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

On April 24, we served 69 families, or 226 individuals (93 adults, 61 children, and 72 seniors).

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 75 boxes; distributed 57 the first day, 14 on the second day, and 4 were carried over into May.

USDA Farmers to Families Food Boxes (CFAP)

We continue to receive boxes from Baptists on Mission through the CFAP Program.
