New Publicity Chairperson Appointed

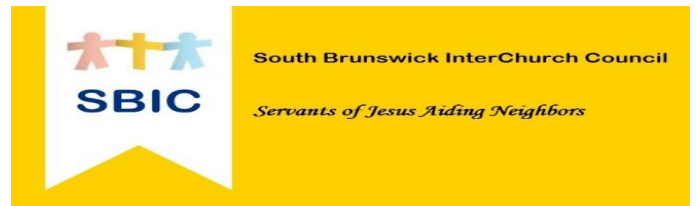

On November 27, we served 51 families, or 197 individuals (43 children, 102 adults, and 52 seniors).

We received 65 boxes; 48 distributed on November 13; and 17 on November 20. All boxes for the month were distributed.
