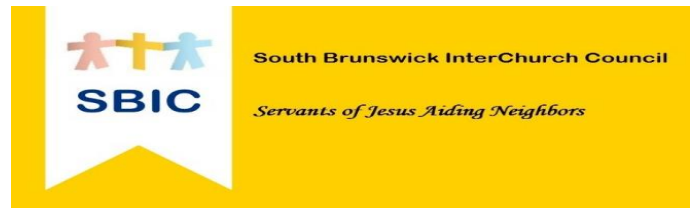

## The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

On January 29, we served 44 families, or 145 individuals (37 children, 65 adults, and 43 seniors).

## Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 70 boxes; 50 distributed on January 15; 8 on January 22, and 9 on January 29. Three boxes were left over.

## Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up

We are periodically receiving Brunswick Wellness Coalition food boxes (similar to Senior boxes) and are receiving produce at the Food Bank through this program.

## Easter Brunch Box

Easter Brunch Boxes will be distributed to 85 families on Palm Saturday. Boxes may contain such items as pancake mix, syrup, grits, eggs, and ham.
