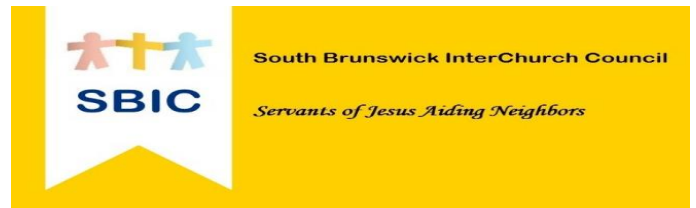

### The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

On July 31, we served 53 families, or 206 individuals (75 adults, 57 children, and 74 seniors).

### Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 75 boxes; 42 distributed on July 12; 19 on July 19; 8 on July 24; and 5 on July 31. All except 1 box was distributed.
