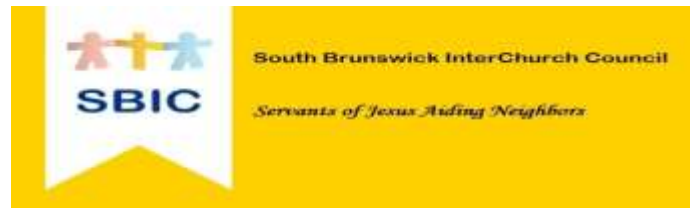
PORCH – The Lords Food Pantry received 1,020 pounds of food in September from the PORCH collection.

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

In September, we served 80 families, or 243 individuals (56 children, 104 adults, and 83 seniors).

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 70 boxes in September. We distributed 41 on September 10, 28 on September 17, and 1 on September 24.

Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up

We are periodically receiving Brunswick Wellness Coalition food boxes (similar to Senior boxes) and are receiving produce at the Food Bank through this program.

Healthy Opportunities Pilot Program (HOP)

We delivered 44 HOP boxes in September.
