We received 70 boxes in December. We distributed 49 boxes on December 10, and 21 on December 17.

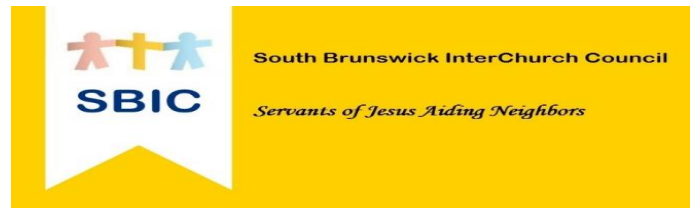
Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up
