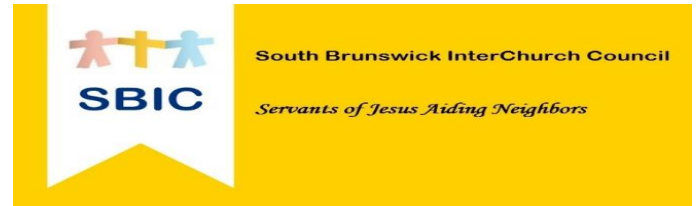

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

On June 26, we served 90 families, or 266 individuals (100 adults, 65 children, and 101 seniors).

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)
