Grants – The SBIC received three grants in June:


- Food Lion Feeds \$3,000

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

In June, we served 77 families, or 235 individuals (52 children, 102 adults, and 81seniors).

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 80 boxes in June. We distributed 61 boxes on June 10, and 19 on June 17.

Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up

We are periodically receiving Brunswick Wellness Coalition food boxes (similar to Senior boxes) and are receiving produce at the Food Bank through this program.

We delivered 20 HOP boxes in June.
