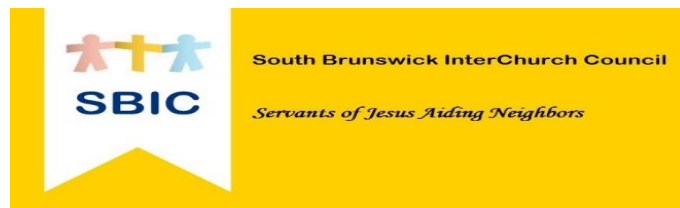

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

On February 26, we served 92 families, or 300 individuals (73 children, 125 adults, and 102 seniors).

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 70 boxes; 50 distributed on February 12; 8 on February 19, and 8 on February 26. Four boxes were left over.

Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up

We are periodically receiving Brunswick Wellness Coalition food boxes (similar to Senior boxes) and are receiving produce at the Food Bank through this program.

Easter Tote Bags

Easter Tote Bags will be distributed to 85 families on Palm Saturday. Bags may contain such items as pancake mix, syrup, grits, eggs, and a canned ham.
