

Providing Help and Hope Since 1981

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

In July, we served 66 families, or 191 individuals (42 children, 75 adults, and 74 seniors).

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 70 boxes in July. We distributed 61 on July 9; 7 on July 16; 1 on July 23; and 1 on July 30.

Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up

We are periodically receiving Brunswick Wellness Coalition food boxes (similar to Senior boxes) and are receiving produce at the Food Bank through this program.

Healthy Opportunities Pilot Program (HOP)

We have received the initial boxes of food and will begin distribution in August. This program is similar to Senior boxes but is only available to those on Medicaid. Recipients sign up through HHS, who refers the participants to the Food Bank, and their names are then assigned to the nearest contractor (The Lords Food Pantry in Brunswick County). Participants will receive one or two sets of low sodium food every week either by picking it up at The Lords Food Pantry on Saturdays between 12:30 – 3:00 p.m., or by having the food delivered to their residence.
