## SHARING SPACE WITH NEW HOPE CLINIC


The Lords Food Pantry will begin sharing a small part of its space in May with New Hope Clinic on Wednesday afternoons from 1:00-4:00 p.m.

#### The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

In March, we served 96 families, or 300 individuals (69 children, 131 adults, and 100 seniors).

#### Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 70 boxes in March. We distributed 59 boxes on March 11, and 11 on March 18.

#### Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up

We are periodically receiving Brunswick Wellness Coalition food boxes (similar to Senior boxes) and are receiving produce at the Food Bank through this program.

#### Healthy Opportunities Pilot Program (HOP)

We delivered 31 HOP boxes in March.

#### **Easter Breakfast Bags Packed**

A total of 110 Easter Breakfast Bags were packed at The Lords Food Pantry on Friday, April 7, and 106 of them were distributed on Saturday, April 8. The bags contained pancake mix, syrup, juice boxes, ham, eggs, grapes, and oranges.
